COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER



Kathryn Ott Lovell

Commissioner of Philadelphia Parks & Recreation

A lifelong Philadelphian, Kathryn Ott Lovell is one of her city's biggest champions. Kathryn was appointed commissioner of Philadelphia Parks & Recreation by Mayor Jim Kenney in January 2016. In this position, Kathryn oversees 700 full-time employees, more than 2,700 part-time and seasonal employees, over 10,200 acres of land, 500 buildings, 166 miles of trail, 250 playgrounds, and thousands of programs and events throughout Philadelphia's parks and recreation system.

As Commissioner of Philadelphia Parks & Recreation, Kathryn is leading one of the nation's largest urban parks and recreation systems through a period of unprecedented growth and change. Under her leadership, the department implemented its first strategic plan to create a more equitable staffing model; developed innovative and relevant programs; and built a citizen-centric parks and recreation system that responds to the needs and aspirations of Philadelphians.

Prior to her appointment as Commissioner, Kathryn served as the Executive Director of the Fairmount Park Conservancy, where she grew the organization's impact, laying the groundwork for the golden age of public spaces Philly enjoys today. Prior to that, she served as Chief Advancement Officer for Mural Arts Philadelphia.

Currently, Kathryn serves on the Board of Directors for the Please Touch Museum, Schuylkill River Development Corporation, Parkway Council, Free Library of Philadelphia, The Mann Center for Performing Arts and the Philadelphia Sports Congress.

Health and Human Development College Marshal

Sara Jimenez Rincon, daughter of Martha Rincon and Fernando Jimenez of North Wales, Pennsylvania, will serve as college marshal for the College of Health and Human Development at Penn State's spring commencement ceremony on Sunday, May 7, 2023.

Jimenez Rincon will graduate with bachelor's degrees in both biobehavioral health and nutritional sciences. She served as a leader in the Schreyer Honors College Student Council, most recently as vice president during the 2022-23 academic year.

As a Schreyer Honors Scholar, Jimenez Rincon conducted a thesis project, "Food Insecurity, Anxiety, and Physical Activity Among College Students, Before and During the COVID-19 Pandemic." She was also an advocacy leader for Days for Girls, an organization dedicated to advancing menstrual equity, health, and dignity for all who menstruate.

Jimenez Rincon was a research assistant in [The Na Lab](#), which investigates community and public health nutrition research in the U.S. and around the world, and was lead author on an article published in Nutrition Journal. She was also the student engagement and outreach assistant for Penn State University Library Learning Services.

Jimenez Rincon received College of Health and Human Development Summer Research Grants in 2021 and 2022 and an Erickson Discovery Grant from Penn State in 2022. She received the Penn State Presidential Academic Excellence Award three times and was also awarded the Victoria N. Price Memorial Scholarship.

In addition to her degrees in in biobehavioral health and nutritional sciences, Jimenez Rincon is enrolled in the Penn State College of Medicine's Integrated Undergraduate-Graduate Accelerated Master of Public Health program where she will work toward a master's degree in public health with a focus on community and behavioral health.

Pino was a Schreyer Honors Scholar, and her thesis was titled, "Infant and Young Child Feeding Practices and Barriers to Achieving Optimal Nutrition in Indigenous Guatemalan Caregivers."

In the future, Pino hopes to focus on global health nutrition for a world-wide organization, such as UNICEF or The World Health Organization.

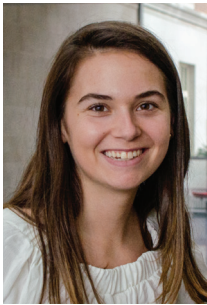


Kinesiology

Athletic Training

Nancy Williams, B.S., M.A., Sc.D., Professor of Kinesiology and Physiology
Head, Department of Kinesiology

The program provides a student-centered curriculum designed to prepare learners for a career in athletic training, which is recognized by the American Medical Association as an allied health care profession. Candidates that satisfy accreditation standards are eligible to sit for the national Board of Certification exam required to earn the ATC credential and practice within the scope of state regulatory boards. Graduates go on to careers in diverse settings that include, but are not limited to, professional sports, performing arts, industry, and government service agencies. Beginning in summer 2023, the program will transition from a bachelor's to master's level in accordance with the current AT Strategic Alliance Degree Statement.

Biobehavioral Health

Thomas Gould, B.S., Ph.D., Jean Phillips Shibley Professor of Biobehavioral Health
Head, Department of Biobehavioral Health

Biobehavioral Health is an innovative, integrative major that examines health as emerging from the interaction of biological, psychological, behavioral, social, and environmental factors. It offers a strong foundation for students interested in epidemiology, psychology, genetics, neuroscience, public health, human development, health promotion, and human service, and for those interested in conducting biomedical research or continuing their education in clinical health and medical fields.

Communication Sciences and Disorders

Diane L. Williams, B.S., M.A., Ph.D., Professor of Communication Sciences and Disorders
Head, Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders

Communication Sciences and Disorders is a program in which students study the prevention and rehabilitation of speech, language, swallowing, and hearing problems. It has been a national leader for more than seventy-five years. The major draws on linguistics, acoustics, psychology, neuroscience, and anatomy and physiology. Undergraduate students typically go on to graduate study and to gain professional certification and licensure in either Speech-Language Pathology or Audiology or other related areas.

Health Policy and Administration

Head, Department of Health Policy and Administration

Health Policy and Administration graduates have the knowledge, skills, and values appropriate to work in entry-level management or policy-related positions—or for the pursuit of graduate education in health policy, health law, health services research, public health, and other health-related fields. Tasked with coordinating a wide variety of activities that are vital to the delivery of health services and programs, health administrators and policymakers play key roles in addressing the complex societal challenges associated with providing access to quality health care at a reasonable cost. Penn State's Health Policy and Administration department has over 55 years of experience teaching undergraduates about healthcare.

Hospitality Management

Marvin Ashner Endowed Director, School of Hospitality Management

The School of Hospitality Management was established in 1937 and is among the oldest and most respected programs of its kind in the nation. Its top-ranked undergraduate, professional master, and doctoral programs prepare global leaders with rigorous, diverse curricula focused, since its inception on engaged scholarship. It is the home of the oldest alumni program group at Penn State with many internationally prominent hospitality firms seeking to recruit its graduates.

Human Development and Family Studies

Douglas Teti, B.S., M.S., Ph.D., Distinguished Professor of Human Development and Family Studies and Professor of Psychology and Pediatrics
Head, Department of Human Development and Family Studies

Human Development and Family Studies prepares students to work in areas such as child care, aging, family services, drug and alcohol rehabilitation, health services, and other human service fields. Graduates also are in demand in human resource management. Many students go on to graduate study. The major has two options: Life Span Human Services and Life Span Developmental Science.

Kinesiology

Nancy Williams, B.S., M.A., Sc.D., Professor of Kinesiology and Physiology
Head, Department of Kinesiology

Kinesiology offers a comprehensive program in the study of human movement and is designed for students who want to prepare for professions involving physical activity and for graduate study in related areas. The Kinesiology major includes two options at University Park: Applied Exercise and Health and Movement Science. These options provide concentrated programs of study designed to prepare students for graduate and professional schools, particularly physical therapy and allied health professions, as well as careers in the fitness and wellness industries, teaching, and medical specialties.

Nutritional Sciences

Meg Bruening, B.S., MPH, RD, Ph.D., Professor of Nutritional Sciences
Head, Department of Nutritional Sciences

Nutritional Sciences majors study how the body uses nutrients for growth and development, how needs change throughout life, and how food contributes to health. The Nutrition and Dietetics option incorporates medical nutrition therapy, nutrition education and counseling, culinary principles of nutrition, and business management. It meets the accreditation standards set by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics. The Nutritional Physiology and Biochemistry option incorporates knowledge from biology, chemistry, physiology, and physics with nutrition. The Behavioral Nutrition and Public Health option integrates social and behavioral sciences with human physiology and nutrition to improve the health and well-being of individuals and populations. Graduates work in diverse settings within the food and nutrition field including hospitals, community agencies, sports nutrition, schools, and food and pharmaceutical industries; many of our graduates will complete post-baccalaureate training and education to become a Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN). Graduates also go on to medical or dental school, or graduate programs and research.

Recreation, Park, and Tourism Management

Peter Newman, B.A., M.S., Ph.D., Martin Professor of Recreation, Park, and Tourism Management
Head, Department of Recreation, Park, and Tourism Management

The mission of the department of Recreation, Park, and Tourism Management is to engage all people in recreation, park, tourism, and leisure activities to enhance individual and community health and well-being. Our majors study in one of four options; Commercial Recreation leading to careers in sport management, travel/tourism, attractions and resorts; Community Recreation leading to careers in municipal recreation, parks, and non-profit organizations; Outdoor Recreation leading to careers in environmental education, natural and cultural history interpretation, park and outdoor facilities management, and adventure based recreation; and PGA Professional Golf Management leading to careers in the golf industry as PGA professionals.
